Emergency Assistance through Workforce Connections

Emergency Assistance provides assistance with establishing permanent housing for persons with minor children who are facing homelessness, have an eviction or foreclosure notice or who have experienced a flood, fire, or other natural disaster. Services are available in Pepin, Buffalo, Trempealeau, Jackson, La Crosse, Monroe, Vernon and Crawford counties. Prevention Priority List/Coordinated Entry System

If you are in need of rental assistance, certain agencies in Vernon, Monroe, Crawford, and La Crosse utilize a system called the Priority List. In order to receive certain rental assistance, you must be placed on this list. All household sizes are welcome and encouraged to apply. Being placed on the Priority List, does not guarantee rental assistance and you are encouraged to seek additional resources. Assistance is based on funding restrictions and current agency caseloads. The following agencies participate and can place households on this list. (You only need to contact one agency as they all do the same assessment and utilize the same list.)
