## Project Recovery



Project Recovery assists survivors of floods and severe storms in federally-declared disaster areas. Outreach workers assist residents, farmers, and business owners with organizing and prioritizing recovery tasks and external demands placed by recovery organizations, and by offering referrals to recovery resources. Outreach workers are also available to help with problem solving, conflict resolution, stress management, and developing plans to address unmet needs.

## Energy Efficiency



### Weatherization Program

If you qualify for Energy Assistance through your county you may qualify for the Weatherization Assistance Program. The program helps individuals or families improve the energy efficiency of their residences. Weatherization can be done for homeowners or renters. Common services include insulating attics and sidewalls, air-sealing the structure, furnace inspections, and energy conservation measures such as lighting and refrigerator replacement. Work is done at no cost for qualifying households.
